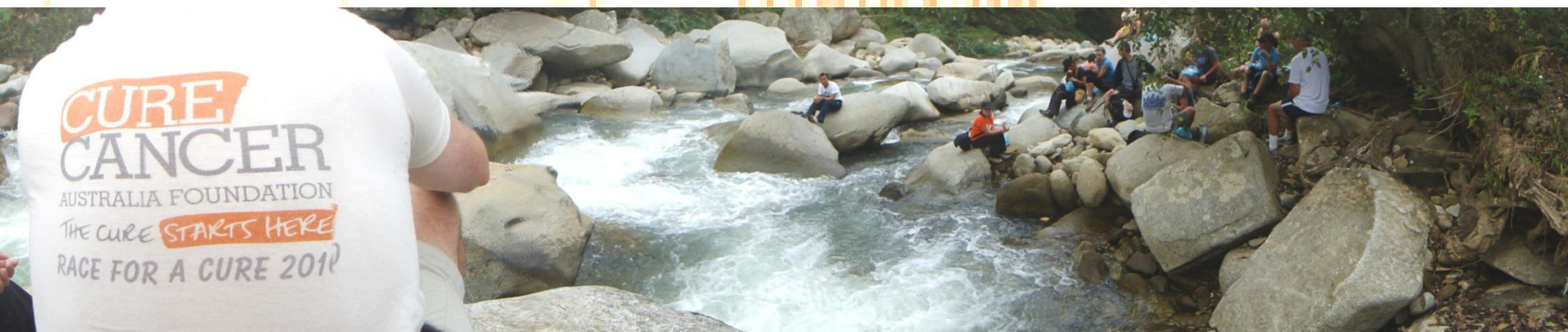


In November 2010, a group of 18 intrepid travellers set off on an inspired adventure.
